

Is a Police Information Check Necessary?

Volunteers work with vulnerable persons may/may not require a Police Information Check or Vulnerable Sector Check. Use these examples as a tool to explore making a determination.

ELEMENTS OF THE POSITION

POSITION TITLE	Swimming Assistant Volunteer
DUTIES/ACTIVITIES	Assist with swimming activities for residents with disabilities. Enhance enjoyment of pool activity and promote client's comfort and safety in the water. Accompany client into the swimming pool; may need to assist client with changing of clothes and entering and exiting the pool.
CLIENT/PEOPLE SERVED	Person with special needs physical/developmental disability ages 15 - 45.
LOCATION/SETTING	Group activities take place on agency's premises.
SUPERVISION/TRAINING	Swimming facility at local community centre.
OTHER DETAILS	Sensitive to the need and challenges faced by people with disabilities.
